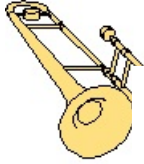

The world famous, **Glenn Miller Orchestra** is the most popular and sought after big band in the world today. With its unique jazz sound, the Glenn Miller Orchestra is considered to be one of the greatest bands of all time.

In an era of blaring brass, rinky-dink pianos and throbbing drums, a young orchestra leader named Glenn Miller was seeking ways to keep his head above water, keep his band together and create a unique sound. He found his sound by muting the brass, featuring the mellow sound of the trombone and turning the lead over to the reeds. By creating the unmistakable "Glenn Miller" sound, the orchestra rose to an exalted position among the finest groups of the Big Band Era.



The career of Captain Glenn Miller ended in 1944 when his plane went down over the English Channel, but his musical heritage and memory lives on. Under the musical direction of Larry O'Brien, those same sounds come alive. The years roll away to the tunes of *Moonlight Serenade*, *Perfidia*, *Jukebox Saturday Night*, and *Little Brown Jug* among others. One of the most arresting pieces is the mellow sound of O'Brien's trombone as he re-creates in the Miller style the haunting strains of *Danny Boy*. The talent of the orchestra under the direction of Larry O'Brien is truly remarkable.

Before the show, we'll dine at the **Cambridge House Brew Pub**, adjoining the Warner Theatre. It's owners sought to combine the *look of a classic English pub with the casual, "everybody-knows-your-name"* ambience of a neighborhood place. In other words, you'll feel at home here. Unlike some brew pubs, the chef at The Cambridge House plays second fiddle to no one. *(Other restaurants are available.)*
