

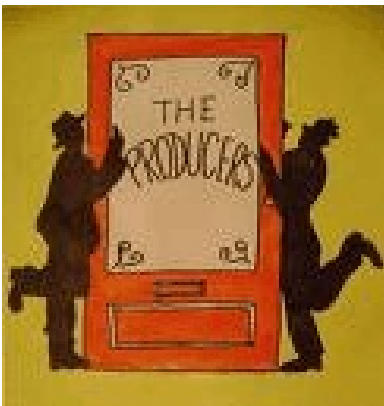

With lunch at the new CAMBRIDGE HOUSE BREW PUB

The **Warner Theatre** has undergone extensive restoration of the lobbies and auditorium. Today, this beautiful theater is one of twelve remaining art deco theaters in the northeast. It is on the National Register of Historic Landmarks and produces critically acclaimed stage plays and shows featuring top-star entertainers. Today's feature is the Tony winner *The Producers*.

*The Producers* is the story of down-on-his luck theatrical producer, Max Bialystock who was once the king of Broadway, but now all his shows close on opening night. Things turn around when he's visited by the neurotic accountant Leo Bloom. Together, they hatch the ultimate scam: to over-finance a "guaranteed-to-close-in-one-night" flop and pocket the difference. They produce a musical called *Springtime for Hitler* written by escaped Nazi Franz Liebken. Then they get the insanely flamboyant Roger De Bris to direct. Finally, they hire as a lead actress the loopy Swedish bombshell Ulla (whose last name has over 15 syllables). But what will they do when their Broadway brainchild becomes a smash hit?

Before the show, we'll dine at the new **Cambridge House Brew Pub**, adjoining the Warner Theatre. It's owners sought to combine the *look of a classic English pub with the casual, "everybody-knows-your-name"* ambience of a neighborhood place. In other words, you'll feel at home here. Unlike some brew pubs, the chef at The Cambridge House plays second fiddle to no one.
